

Sucker Spawn

Tommy Baranowski of CTFishGuides.com showed how to tie the Sucker Spawn when he and Derrick Kirkpatrick discussed fishing for steelhead and big browns in New York and Pennsylvania Tributaries on Oct. 16, 2012.



Recipe:

- Size 8 heavy gauge hook
- 3 strands of Micro Yarn
- Thread to match color of yarn

Tying steps:

- Start the thread at the eye and tie back to the bend.
- Tie in the yarn and clip.
- Create five graduated loops, from the bend forward, starting and ending small with the largest loop in the middle.
- Crowd the eye of the hook with the yarn when making the final loop.
- Whip finish.
