## **Sucker Spawn**

Tommy Baranowski of <u>CTFishGuides.com</u> showed how to tie the Sucker Spawn when he and Derrick Kirkpatrick discussed fishing for steelhead and big browns in New York and Pennsylvania Tributaries on Oct. 16, 2012.



## Recipe:

- Size 8 heavy gauge hook
- 3 strands of Micro Yarn
- Thread to match color of yarn

## **Tying steps:**

- Start the thread at the eye and tie back to the bend.
- Tie in the yarn and clip.
- Create five graduated loops, from the bend forward, starting and ending small with the largest loop in the middle.
- Crowd the eye of the hook with the yarn when making the final loop.
- Whip finish.
